


# RIBERA DEL DUERO

**4** in Segovia and **19** in Soria



## CLIMATE

- Continental-Mediterranean
- Less heat retention during the growing season compared to other Spanish wine regions
- Dry summers with considerable day/night temperature fluctuation
- Spring and early autumn frosts prior to harvesting

## WINES

- Deep-coloured, structured, with powerful tannins
- Relatively low acidity in Tempranillo
- Suitable to lay down
